**DENVER (Oct. 24, 2011)** — The American Institute of Architects Denver Chapter (AIA Denver), in partnership with *Luxe Interiors + Design Magazine™*, recognized its 2011 Architects' Choice Awards (ACA) winners during a reception on Friday, Oct. 21, at the ESC THUL Experience Center in Denver. This awards program recognizes excellence in design and construction of residential projects of all scopes and budgets, from new construction to remodels and renovations. All residential developments, from single-family homes to lofts and new construction to additions, are eligible for awards.

Entries are judged on the following criteria:

- Strength of design ideas.
- Aesthetic and market appeal.
- Sensitivity to existing structures and neighborhood.
- Appropriate use of building materials.
- Craftsmanship.
- Compliance with entry requirements.
- Standard-setting for the community.
- Success in meeting client's goals.
