About Will Bruder, AIA

Self-trained as an architect, Bruder has a Bachelor of Fine Arts degree in sculpture from the University of Wisconsin-Milwaukee. Supplementing his studio art education were studies in structural engineering, philosophy, art history and urban planning, followed by a full architectural apprenticeship under Gunnar Birkerts and Paolo Soleri. Subsequent to becoming registered, Bruder opened his own studio in 1974. Most of Bruder’s 450 commissions have celebrated the craft of building in ways not typical in contemporary architecture, striving to invent form specific to function and client aspirations. Through his creative use of materials and light, Bruder’s ability to raise the ordinary to the extraordinary is renowned.
