The American Institute of Architects, Colorado North Chapter, Recognizes 2010 Achievements in Architecture

DENVER (Sept. 28, 2010)—The American Institute of Architects (AIA), Colorado North chapter, recognized its 2010 architectural design and honor award recipients on Friday, Sept. 10, during a presentation at the Stanley Hotel in Estes Park, Colo.

The jury was chaired by Randy Brown, FAIA, principal of Randy Brown Architects (Omaha, Neb.). (Note: honor awards are the highest achievement, followed by merit, then citation.)

Firm of the Year

Barrett Studio Architects (Boulder, Colo.)

This award recognizes a firm that has contributed to the profession and has set an example in design, service and leadership to AIA Colorado North over a period of at least 10 years.

Architect of the Year

Roger Thorp, AIA, Thorp Associates, P.C., Architects and Planners (Estes Park, Colo.)

This award recognizes a licensed architect who has contributed to the profession and set an example in design, service and leadership to AIA Colorado North over a period of at least 10 years.

Associate of the Year

Arlo Schumann, Assoc. AIA, RB+B Architects, Inc. (Fort Collins, Colo.)

This award recognizes an unlicensed architectural intern who is an associate member of AIA Colorado North, whose contributions to the profession of architecture in AIA Colorado North have been outstanding.

Lifetime Achievement

Charles Haertling, AIA (awarded posthumously)

This award recognizes an architect who has made significant contributions to AIA, the profession and the citizens of the AIA Colorado North area over a lifetime of work.

25-Year Award

Hobart D. Wagener, FAIA (awarded posthumously)

This award recognizes a project completed in the AIA Colorado North area 25 to 35 years ago that has withstood the "test of time" and still functions in its original capacity.

Mentor of the Year

Harvey Hine, AIA, Harvey M. Hine Architecture & Interiors (Boulder, Colo.)

This award recognizes a firm or licensed architect member for exceptional efforts to promote the professional growth and development of an emerging design professional, or group of emerging professionals, who is/are in the process of acquiring a license(s).

Community Service by an Architect

Ian Shuff, AIA, Aller-Lingle-Massey Architects, P.C. (Fort Collins, Colo.)

This award recognizes a licensed architect member of AIA Colorado North for exemplary contribution of service to the community.

Contribution to the Built Environment by a Non-Architect

Morgan Creek Ventures (Boulder, Colo.)

This award recognizes outstanding accomplishments by a non-architect in the AIA Colorado North region who has demonstrated exemplary achievements in contributing to the quality of the built environment.
